Bethlehem, PA, October 23, 2007 – The law firm of Cohen & Feeley and community-founded Team Capital Bank announced that they will team up on the Best of the Best Scholarship Program for the 2007-2008 school year. In its 13th year, the Best of the Best Scholarship Program was created by Cohen & Feeley to recognize outstanding seniors at local high schools. While it will be administered and run the same as in previous years, the Cohen & Feeley – Team Capital Bank partnership will create enhancements to the Best of the Best Scholarship program: student scholarships will be increased this year and a Team Capital Bank Community Service Award will be added to recognize outstanding service inside and outside the student’s school community.

The Best of the Best Scholarship Program begins in September when applications are distributed to area high schools. Selection criteria include academic achievement, extra-curricular activities, community service, writing samples, and any adverse circumstances a student may have overcome. The scholarship committee selects a student from each of the 27 area high schools. Each student selected receives a scholarship and a \$100 contribution to the charity of their choice. This year the actual scholarship to each student will be increased from \$100 to \$250. As always, two students, one male and one female, will be chosen as the Best of the Best. The current scholarship received by each of these students is \$500 and will be raised to \$750. In addition, a Team Capital Bank Community Service Award scholarship in the amount of \$500 will be given to a student to be selected from all of the applicants. The students and their parents or guardians are guests at an Awards Breakfast held in the spring.

“The increased support from the partnership of Cohen & Feeley and Team Capital Bank will allow us to honor these outstanding students in an expanded way and create additional visibility for the Best of the Best Scholarship Program,” said Deane Feeley, Best of the Best Program Director. “We started this awards program 13 years ago and we are delighted that
